Expedition 9 crew arrives at International Space Station

Expedition 9 Cmdr. Gennady Padalka and NASA science officer and flight engineer Mike Fincke entered their new home for the first time Wednesday. Their Russian spacecraft docked with the International Space Station at 12:01 a.m. CDT and they entered the orbiting science outpost about one hour later. Also joining them is European Space Agency astronaut Andre Kuipers of the Netherlands, who will conduct nine days of experiments before returning to Earth with the Expedition 8 crew -- Cmdr. Mike Foale and flight engineer Alexander Kaleri.
