DART spacecraft set to launch Tuesday from Vandenberg

NASA's Demonstration of Autonomous Rendezvous Technology (DART) spacecraft is on track to launch at 1:13 P.M. CDT Tuesday from Vandenberg Air Force Base in California. The mission is an in-space demonstration of an autonomous rendezvous prototype system. It will demonstrate key technologies required for spacecraft to rendezvous with other craft, such as satellites. Live coverage on NASA TV begins at noon CDT.
