STS-90 to Fly Marshall Facility; Mission Briefings to Air Thurs.

A Marshall Microgravity Research experiment facility, called the bioreactor, is scheduled to fly aboard STS-90. The 16-day mission to study the human nervous system is planned for launch at 1:19 p.m. April 16. Mission briefings will air Thursday on NASA TV with a mission overview at 8 a.m., a neurolab overview at 9:30 a.m., a neurolab science briefing at 10:30 a.m., and a crew press conference at 1:30 p.m.
