Marshall Finishes Series of Tests On Air-Breathing Rocket Engine

Marshall engineers and scientists have successfully completed testing a rocket thruster, one component of an air-breathing rocket engine. An air-breathing rocket engine that consumes oxygen in the air -- instead of stored oxidizer -- is one of the technologies Marshall's Advanced Space Transportation Program is pursuing to dramatically reduce the cost of access to space.
