Following a pre-planned series of commands to the Chandra X-ray Observatory from the flight operations team in Cambridge, Mass., the door of the Advanced Charge-Coupled-Device Imaging Spectrometer opened at 5:46 p.m. CDT Sunday. Its opening cleared the way for additional activation and testing of the instrument, to be used to take Chandra's first images later this month.
