## Space Shuttle launch rescheduled Tuesday

The launch of Space Shuttle Endeavour has been rescheduled for 4:45 p.m. CST from the Kennedy Space Center in Florida. The new data will allow sufficient time for a spacewalk to clear an apparent obstruction in a docking mechanism on the International Space Station's Zvezda module. The long-range weather forecast indicates favorable conditions for launch.
