Shuttle Atlantis en route to International Space Station

Space Shuttle Atlantis lifted off from Kennedy Space Center's Launch Pad 39A at 5:13 p.m. CST Wednesday en route to the International Space Station. During the 11-day mission, crew members will install the Destiny research laboratory. Atlantis is scheduled to return to Earth Feb. 18 at about 11:58 a.m. CST.
