NASA Managers to Set Launch Date for Hubble Mission Thurs.

NASA managers will hold a flight readiness review Thursday morning at KSC to review the status of Space Shuttle Discovery and set a launch date for STS-82. The Shuttle is tentatively targeted for launch Feb. 11. STS-82 will mark the second in-orbit Hubble Space Telescope servicing mission. During the mission, astronauts will conduct four spacewalks to replace some of the telescope's components.
