NASA Headquarters Office of Space Flight has approved Marshall's request to implement a significant reorganization at the Center. As part of the realignment, the organization for Associate Director for Science will be eliminated and new Customer and Employee Relations Directorate will be established. The Institutional and Program Support Directorate will be renamed the Center Operations Directorate, and the Management Operations office will move to this new directorate.
