## **Endeavour Docks With Mir; U.S. Astronauts Exchange Places**

For the eighth time in three years, an American Space Shuttle has linked to a Russian Space Station following Endeavour's successful docking to the Mir Saturday. On Sunday, U.S. Astronaut Andy Thomas officially became a member of the Mir-24 crew, exchanging places with David Wolf. Thus far, the transfer of 47 percent of the supplies and equipment has been accomplished. STS-89 is scheduled to land at the Kennedy Space Center Saturday at 4:36 p.m. CST.
