STS-89 crew members have completed three of the six planned runs of the Marshall-managed Mechanics of Granular Materials (MGM) experiment, which has applications in a wide range of fields, including earthquake engineering. The seven astronauts aboard the Shuttle Endeavour also began their third full day of joint-docked operations with the Russian Space Station Mir Tuesday morning. Endeavour is scheduled to complete its eight-day mission this Saturday.
