MSFC-Managed Experiments Stowed on Mir as Shuttle Undocks

Five of the six Marshall-managed Microgravity Research Program experiments on STS-89 have been stowed aboard Mir as the Endeavour crew is preparing to undock with the Russian Space Station. The sixth experiment, mechanics of granular materials, has completed four of its six planned experiment runs , and will return to Earth on Endeavour for data analysis.
