LB&B Associates Inc. of Columbia, Md., has been selected for award of a contract to provide test operations support for Marshall's Science and Engineering Directorate. The contract starts with a one-year base period, followed by four one-year options which may be exercised at NASA's discretion, and could be worth as much as \$30,930,739. The contract provides technician support to operate and maintain Propulsion Laboratory test facilities.
