Marshall Center Team Testing X-33 Guidance and Control Hardware

Team members from Marshall's Astrionics Laboratory and Systems and Dynamics Laboratory are working together, with industry, to test an advanced global positioning unit-aided inertial navigation unit for the X-33 launch vehicle. Engineers are using Marshall's world-class avionics simulation facilities to test the unit, according to Fred Roe, chief of the Simulations and Computer Systems Branch. The X-33 program is a major assignment of the Space Transportation Office at Marshall.
