## Next Chandra observatory activation event set Saturday

The third of five burns of Chandra's onboard liquid apogee engines is scheduled to occur at approximately 5:37 p.m. CDT Saturday. The burn will be conducted at the low point of the orbit to raise Chandra's orbital high point. The engine firing is expected to last 21 minutes, 20 seconds. Another burn is set for 11:56 p.m. CDT Sunday in preparation for the final burn on Wednesday.
