Marshall's Fastrac engine fires successfully in test

A 20-second, full-power test of the Fastrac engine at NASA's Stennis Space Center, Miss., March 11 demonstrated operation of the complete engine system. Fastrac is a 60,000-pound-thrust engine that will be used for the first powered flight of NASA's X-34 technology demonstrator. The Fastrac engine was designed and developed at Marshall.
