X-43A flight briefing on NASA TV Wednesday

A flight briefing on the X-43A Hyper-X program will at 4 p.m. CST Wednesday on NASA TV. The X-43A is tentatively scheduled to fly Saturday at Dryden Flight Research Center in Edwards, Calif. Using air-breathing scramjet engines instead of traditional rocket power, the X-43A is designed to fly from seven-10 times the speed of sound and could represent a major leap forward in providing faster, more reliable and less expensive access to space. Saturday's event will be the second flight of an unpowered research vehicle in the Hyper-X program.
