STS-105 Space Shuttle crew visits Marshall Tuesday

Crew members of the STS-105 Discovery Space Shuttle mission in August will visit the Marshall Center Tuesday. They will present highlights of their mission at 10 a.m. in Morris Auditorium. Discovery carried the Leonardo Multi-Purpose Logistics Module, managed by the Marshall Center, and the Expedition Three crew to the International Space Station. In addition, two EXPRESS Racks and a Materials International Space Station Experiments Project, were delivered. Bus service will be provided.
