A 24-hour simulation of the Marshall-managed fourth U.S. Microgravity Payload (USMP-4) mission is under way. Members of the mission team, including controllers, managers, researchers and crew members at Marshall and JSC, are participating in the training session. The Spacelab mission is targeted for launch on Wednesday, Nov. 19. USMP-4 operations will be led by Mission Manager Sherwood Anderson of Marshall's Flight Projects Office.
