NASA Managers to Hold STS-87 Flight Readiness Review Mon.

A flight readiness review for the STS-87 mission will be held Monday morning at KSC. At the meeting, NASA managers will review the Space Shuttle's launch status for the mission which will carry Marshall's fourth U.S. Microgravity Payload mission. Launch is tentatively scheduled for 1:47 p.m. Wednesday, Nov. 19.
