NASA Administrator Dan Goldin announced Wednesday that Marshall Center Director Art Stephenson would head the Mars Climate Orbiter Mission Failure Investigation Board. The board will look independently into all aspects of the failure of the mission, which was lost Sept. 23 as the spacecraft was entering orbit around Mars.
