Space Shuttle Atlantis lifted off at 7:45 a.m. CDT Friday from Kennedy Space Center, Fla., on an 11-day mission that will open the doors to the International Space Station's new living quarters. Atlantis is scheduled to land at the Kennedy Space Center at about 3 a.m. CDT Sept. 19.
